1. Exclusion of Liability

BIOTEC disclaims any responsibility for damages, broadly defined, that the User may incur as a result of using BIOTEC's website, software, and/or applications, or as a result of lack of access to BIOTEC's website, software, and/or applications, including damages resulting from intentional or gross negligence by BIOTEC's employees, representatives, or agents.

All agreements with BIOTEC are subject to Belgian law. In case of dispute, an amicable resolution will be sought before any legal action. Failing an amicable settlement, the courts of Brussels will have exclusive jurisdiction.

Our Vision on Privacy Protection

BIOTEC processes personal data for various purposes. Ensuring information security is not only a legal requirement for BIOTEC and its products, but also reflects good management and corporate governance. BIOTEC aims to be a reliable partner in all respects.

Collaboration, client focus, quality, and accountability are some of the core values expected of BIOTEC employees. Reliable communication of information, where privacy, integrity, and data availability are guaranteed, is intrinsically linked to these values. BIOTEC has developed an information security policy for this purpose.

It is impossible to provide our services without processing certain personal data. This data is handled with the necessary precautions, in accordance with existing legislation.

What is Personal Data?

Personal data refers to any information (text, objects, or photos) that can identify a living person, directly or indirectly. Examples of personal data include a name, address, email address, phone number, social security number, or a photo. We consider personal data provided by our clients and members to be confidential information, which we do not retain longer than necessary unless required for legal obligations.

How Do We Collect Personal Data?

- In most cases, you provide us with your personal data voluntarily. For example, you share your data when we start working together, when you sign a contract, when you communicate via email/phone/social media, or when you purchase a product.
- If you are or wish to become a supplier or business partner, you also actively provide us with your personal data.
- If you apply for a job at BIOTEC, you share details about your education and work experience with us.

- Occasionally, we may obtain lists and information from other sources that relate indirectly to you. When using this information, we request that the provider ensure the information was obtained legally and that we have the right to acquire and use it.
- When you visit our website or use other software products, we collect anonymous or aggregated data. We use functional cookies and cookies for statistical purposes, such as Google Analytics and Application Insights. For example, we know the type of browser and operating system a visitor uses and how often a person visits our site (anonymously). This data helps us continuously optimize our tools. We may also use techniques to verify if you have opened an email or clicked on a link in an email. By recording such information, we can collect metrics on the use and effectiveness of our websites, software products, and communication. This allows us to make your experience more personalized and better tailor our interactions with you.
- The information we collect, directly or indirectly, may be aggregated to improve its overall accuracy and completeness and to better tailor our interactions with you.
- We may already have extensive information acquired in the past. We do not want to delete this information without consideration if we believe it can provide added value to you.

For What Purposes Do We Use Personal Data?

BIOTEC processes personal data for various purposes. 'Processing' is a broad term that includes everything that can be done with personal data: collecting or deleting, recording, classifying, storing, updating, modifying, requesting, consulting, using, transmitting, disseminating, making available, grouping, linking, protecting, and deleting.

In all cases, BIOTEC processes data only for the purposes for which you specifically provided it. We always assume that we process personal data only when strictly necessary for our organization's objectives. We process personal data only if it provides added value to our clients and members.

If you inform us that you do not want us to use your information for any contact other than processing your requests, we will respect that wish.

Internal Services: HR/Staff

We process staff data for personnel and payroll administration. However, we may also process data obtained directly from third parties. For example, if you apply for a job at BIOTEC, you provide us with details of your education and work experience. Your motivation and skills are also clear. We may verify the references you provide. This information is used only for hiring purposes. In the case of job applications and spontaneous applications, we will inform you if we store your data in our recruitment database, unless otherwise advised.

Client and Member Administration, Support Services

We may use your data to:

- Accurately enter and update it in our administration.
- Verify if you are or can become a client or member.
- Evaluate and manage your service and product requests, and possibly invoice them.
- Contact you to respond to your queries or comments, share information, or ask you questions.
- Ensure you can use our website and applications.
- Provide you with useful information for the effective exercise of your profession or to facilitate your administration. For example, we inform you of our activities, products, and projects and send newsletters. Of course, you always have the option to unsubscribe.

Improvement, Development, and Scientific Objectives

- We use personal data to make our product more personalized. For example, we can
 measure how our clients use our product and the outcome of a campaign. Based on this
 data, we can improve our product.
- Develop new products.
- Prepare reports based on available data. Pricing data is also analyzed for 'business purposes'. During analysis, we remove personal data we do not need. We also collect data at a certain level of abstraction (aggregate), encrypt (pseudonymize), or anonymize it.
- We also create various customer groups (profiles) with similar characteristics or behaviors. We can then respond by offering tailored services and information.

How Long Do We Retain Your Personal Data?

Your data is retained for the time necessary to fulfill the tasks you request or as required by law. For example, accounting documents must be kept for 10 years according to current legislation.

With Whom Do We Share Your Personal Data?

- Generally, BIOTEC does not share your personal information with anyone. Data
 provided is never disclosed to third parties without a specific legal basis, your consent, or
 your knowledge.
- We may be required to disclose information about you when legally mandated by law, regulations, or legal procedures (such as a court order) or when requested by government agencies in the course of law enforcement actions.
- We are assisted in our work by other service providers. We share only the personal data necessary for the specific task they have been entrusted with. For example, if we work with companies and individuals for IT system design, maintenance, and improvement,

- administrative document collection, or certain support services. In all cases, we establish ad hoc agreements with these service providers regarding what they can do with this personal information. We formalize these agreements in contracts.
- If all or part of our business or assets are sold or transferred, we reserve the right to
 transfer all information about you as well. In such cases, we will make reasonable efforts
 to inform you and ensure that the data recipient uses it in accordance with this privacy
 policy. In such a situation, you should contact the data recipient for any questions
 regarding the processing of your data.

How Do We Protect Your Personal Data?

- We ensure robust protection. BIOTEC has implemented administrative, technical, and organizational measures to protect your personal data against loss or any form of unlawful processing. Data is protected by physical and technical access controls.
 Policies and procedures are in place for effective data processing and protection.
- We pay attention to the protection of our systems and personal data. We monitor how
 personal data is used and protected, starting from the design phase. We conduct regular
 security tests during the development of our tools and subsequently. This helps us detect
 potential vulnerabilities and security risks to better protect our systems.
- Those with access to your data on behalf of BIOTEC are bound by confidentiality. All our
 employees have signed confidentiality agreements. BIOTEC also prioritizes continuous
 awareness of information security. Regular awareness campaigns and informational
 sessions are organized for employees. We handle the data you entrust to us with great
 care.

Consulting or Correcting Your Personal Data

- As a member, business partner, supplier, or contact of BIOTEC, you always have the
 right to consult your data processed by BIOTEC. If your data is incorrect or incomplete,
 you can request corrections. You can submit your request in writing via email to

- You may also request deletion of your data or object to its processing if it is not necessary for the described purposes or direct mailings. Such requests must be submitted in writing. For this purpose, send a request to Jv@biotec.be.
- If you no longer wish to receive the information and products we offer, you can always indicate this.
